

Retaining Walls - Wedgestone Classic

Tumbled for that weathered, traditional look, Wedgestone Classic is suited for those outdoor projects where you wish to capture the charm of old world architecture.

GENERAL DETAILS

Because the tumbling process tended to knock the grooves off of standard units, only Coping units are used for Wedgestone Classic.

The maximum exposed (above grade) wall height for Wedgestone Classic is 400 mm (16"). This consists of 4 exposed courses, and requires one additional burried course.

DIMENSIONS

Length: 225 mm tapered to 150 mm (8.9" tapered to 5.9")
 Height: 100 mm (3.93")
 Depth: 200 mm (7.87")



COLOURS

Stock colours include: Autumn Range, Blackwood Range, Granite, Laurentian Range, Robinson Range, Sandstone Range, Timmins Range.

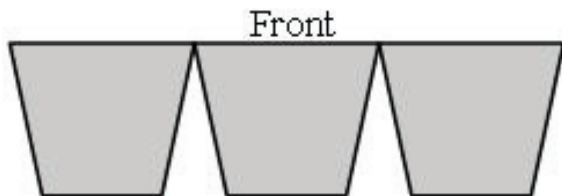
- Wedgestone Classic units are sold individually.

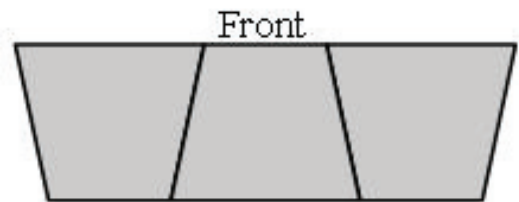
Note: Depends on if units are alternating - Random Face - or if all larger faces are to the front - Uniform Face (see below).

Method A - Uniform Face

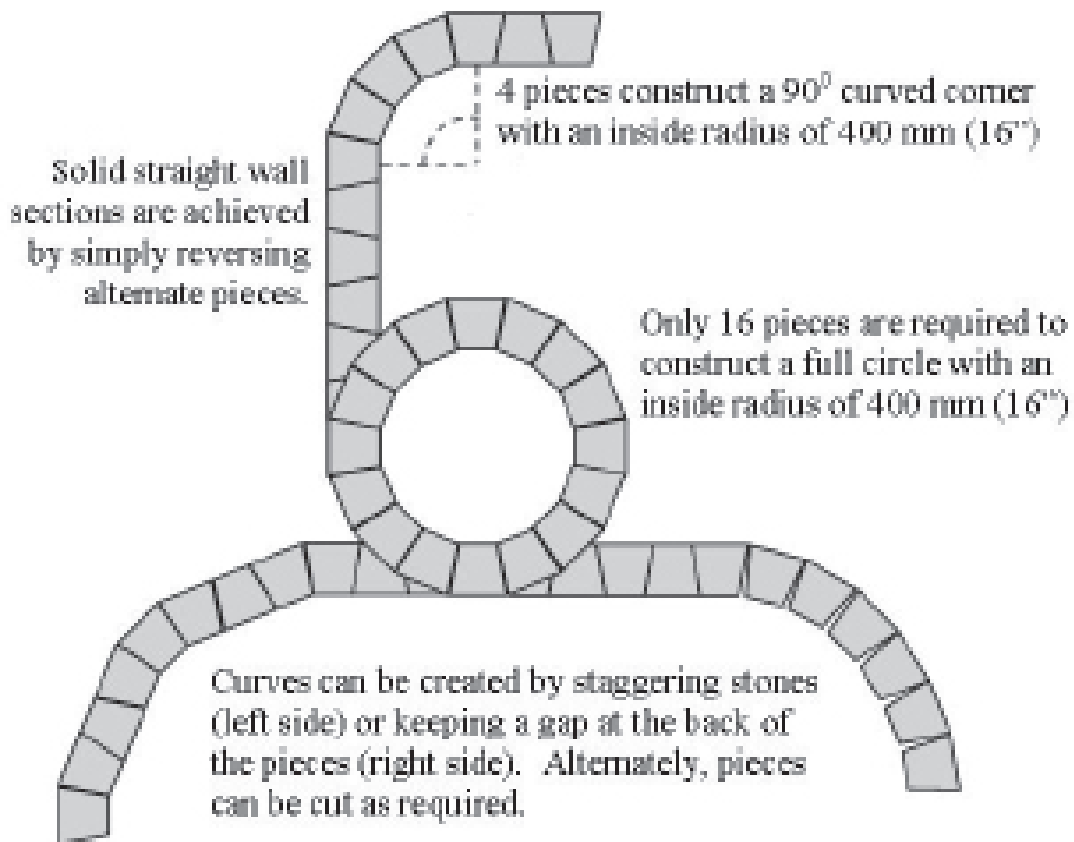


Method B - Random Face

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS



Steps

Curved or half round steps can be created using Wedgestone and Wedgestone Classic. However, it is recommended that the stones be glued together, that 1.5 courses be buried, and that geogrid be incorporated, to prevent any movement.
